Course assessment results for COMPOSITION I (ENG*1013*10) for Fall09.

In this report, you will find detailed analysis of the student responses to each question on the Student Evaluation of Courses just completed. Students were asked to respond "Strongly Agree" (1) ,"Agree" (2) , "Disagree" (3) or "Strongly Disagree" (4) to each of twenty questions listed.

The first set of histograms identifies how many students responded with a rating of 1 through 4 for each item. You will also see values to the right, in smaller type, listing the number of students ($n=$ ___) who responded to EACH question, what the average response was (between 1-4), what the median response was (most frequently rated response) and the standard deviation in the scores assigned by students (the more students agreed with one another on a rating on an item, the smaller the standard deviation; they more their ratings differed from one another, the larger the standard deviation).

In the second set of histograms, the analysis of the average values of all individual questions are listed.


The histograms are followed by your Profile. This profile plots the average of all students' ratings of each item (between 1-4).

Finally, at the end of this report, you will find automatically scanned copies of any student responses to the two open-ended questions -- asking students to comment on the course and the instruction in the course.

We hope you find this presentation of the data helpful to you in your development of your instructional activities.

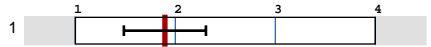

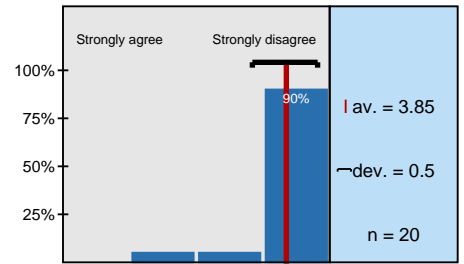
Histogram for scaled questions



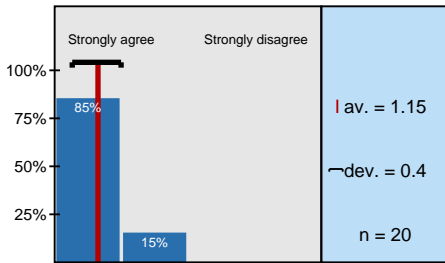
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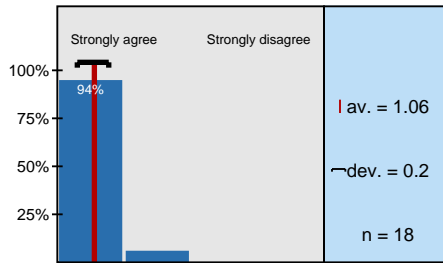
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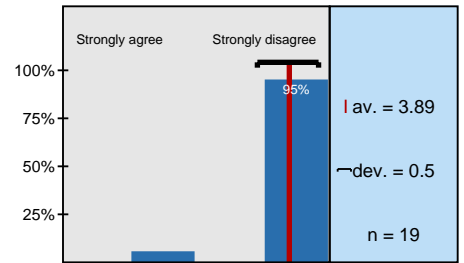
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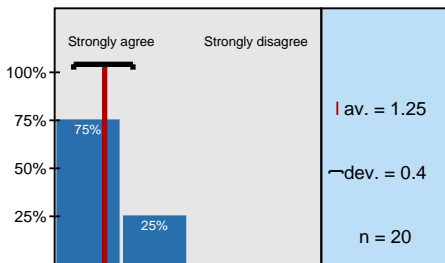
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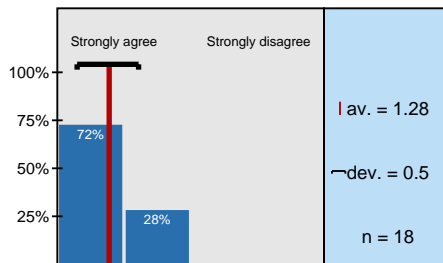
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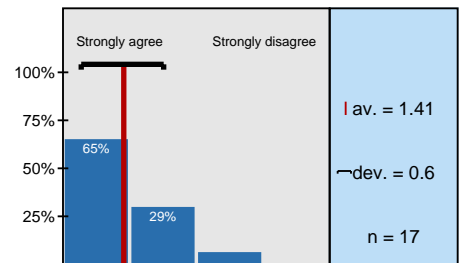
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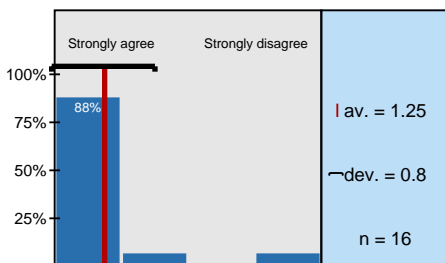
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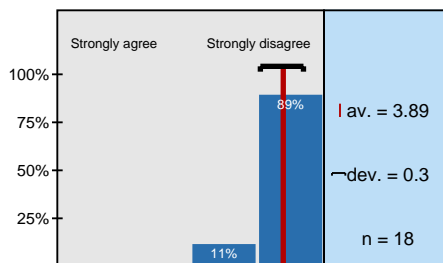
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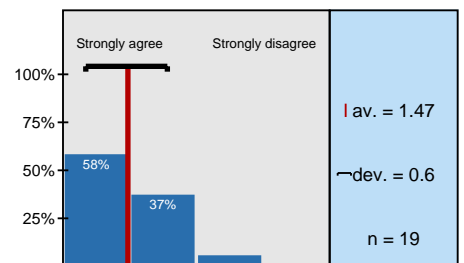
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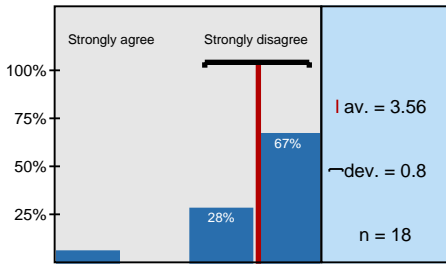
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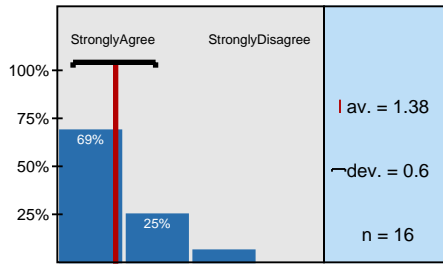
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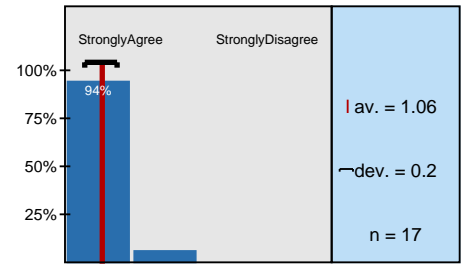
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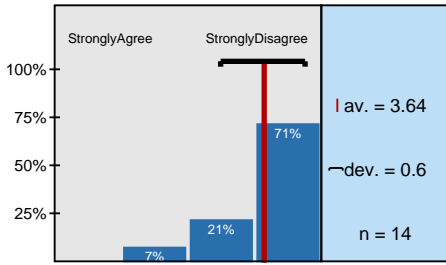
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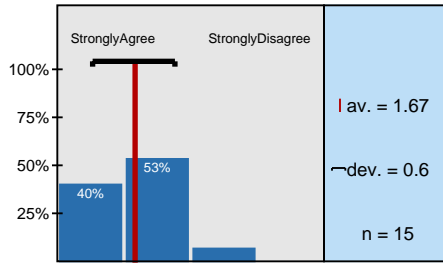
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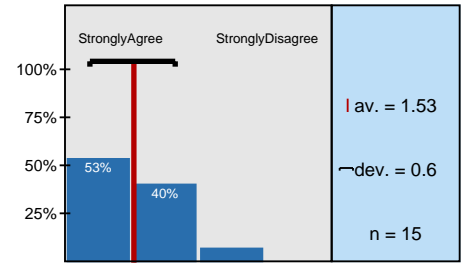
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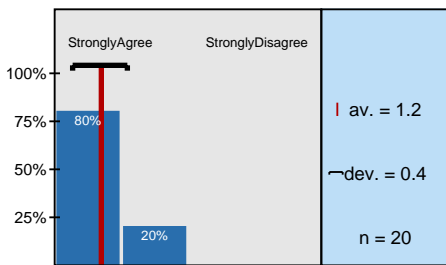
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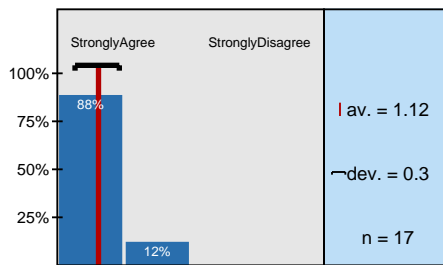
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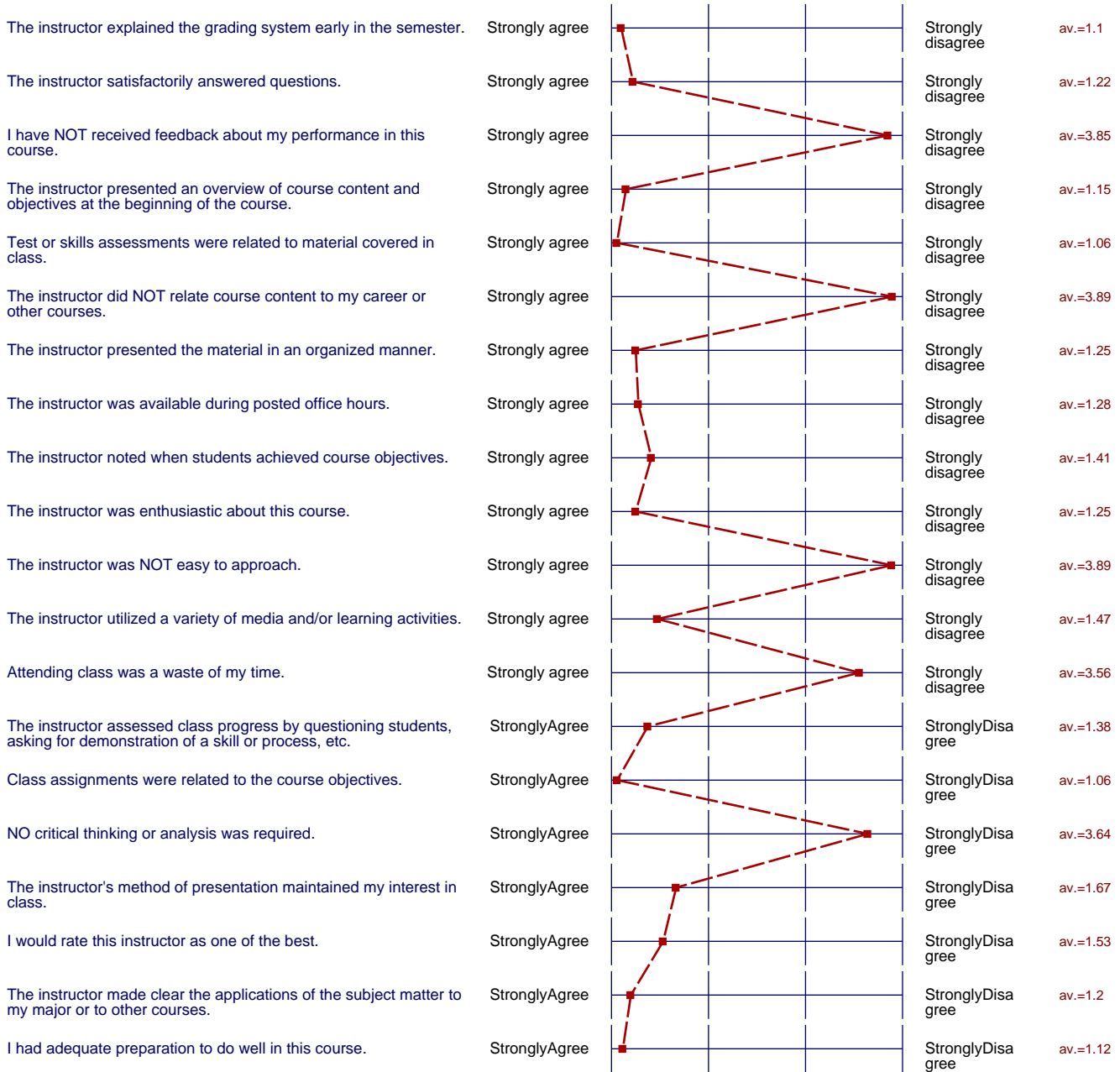
